LAB GUIDELINES

I. LABORATORY REGULATIONS

Violation of the regulations will be subjected to penalty in lab grade.

- (1) Absolutely NO FOOD NOR DRINK in the lab at all time.
- (2) All test equipment neatly placed on the bench.
- (3) Wires hung up neatly on the wall in their proper places.
- (4) Clean up lab bench after finishing your lab.
- (5) Keep a professional environment in the lab.

II. LABORATORY CONDUCT

- (1) Come to the lab well-prepared. Pre-lab must be done before lab time. Have TA sign off your pre-lab work at the beginning of the lab session.
- (2) Record your data neatly and *verify that it makes sense*.
- (3) Demonstrate to TA on your lab work and have him or her sign off your demo at the end.

III. LABORATORY WRITE-UP

- (1) Students can work in pairs, but you each need to write and turn in your own report.
Duplication of your partner's report is NOT acceptable and both will be penalized.
- (2) Place lab coversheet in the first page of your report.
- (3) Follow "Lab Report Format" guideline for proper write-up.
- (4) Lab report is due at the beginning of next lab; TA will grade and return the lab report the week after.
- (5) Lab re-grade must be requested within one week since it is returned.
